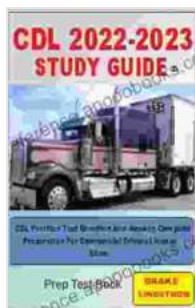

Types of CDL Licenses

There are three main types of CDL licenses:

- **Class A:** Allows you to drive any combination of vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of 26,001 pounds or more, provided the GVWR of the towed vehicle is more than 10,000 pounds.
- **Class B:** Allows you to drive any single vehicle with a GVWR of 26,001 pounds or more, or any such vehicle towing a vehicle with a GVWR of less than 10,000 pounds.
- **Class C:** Allows you to drive any single vehicle with a GVWR of less than 26,001 pounds, or any such vehicle towing a vehicle with a GVWR of less than 10,000 pounds.

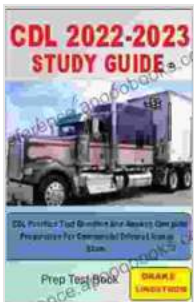

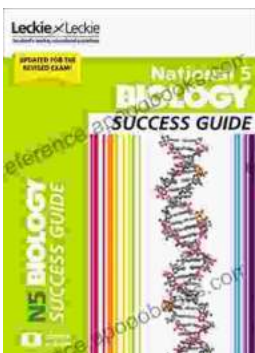
