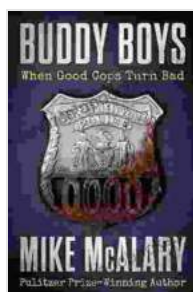


Buddy Boys: When Good Cops Turn Bad

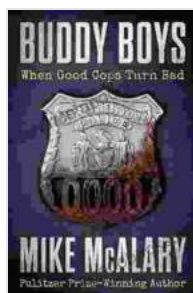

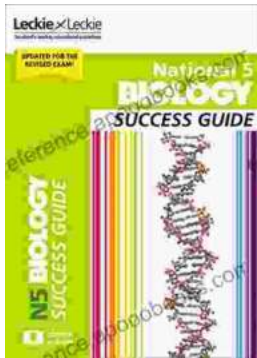

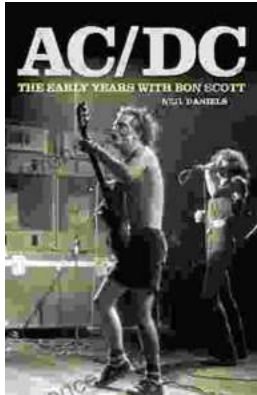
