And a place where the unknown awaits.



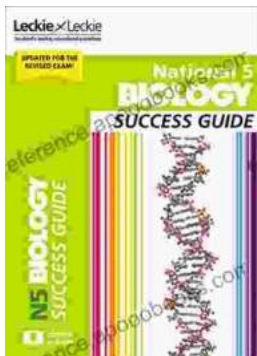
