- Yarn needle


Instructions

2. Round 1: Ch 3, dc in each ch around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 3.
3. Round 2: Ch 3, dc in each dc around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 3.
4. Round 3: Ch 3, *dc in the next dc, ch 3, dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 3.
5. Round 4: Ch 3, *dc in the next ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 3.
6. Round 5: Ch 3, *dc in the next ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in the next ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 3.
7. Round 6: Ch 3, *dc in the next ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in the next ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in the next ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 3.
8. Round 7: Ch 3, *dc in the next ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 3.
9. Round 8: Ch 3, *dc in the next ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 3.
10. Round 9: Ch 3, *dc in the next ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in the next ch-3 space,



12. Round 11: Ch 3, *dc in the next ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 3.
13. Round 12: Ch 3, *dc in the next ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 3.
14. Round 13: Ch 3, *dc in the next ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 3.



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
